The London SIG Bilingualism will:

1.	Provide support regarding cultural competency and working with clients who are bi/multilingual by:  Providing clinicians/student clinicians/assistants/health and education professionals with information regarding study days offered by LSB, National SIG Bilingualism and other organisations e.g. Higher Education Institutions.  Collating information produced by professionals, LSB committee members, National SIG Bilingualism and other agencies.  Providing clinicians/student clinicians/assistants/health and education professionals with resources and advice to be utilised when working with bi/multilingual clients.
2.	Promote research into cultural competency and b/multilingualism by:  Providing forums for discussion and research development that will develop the evidence base for working with bilingual clients  Hosting study days to highlight current research into bilingualism.  To encourage clinicians/SLT students to share recent work that has focused on bi/multilingualism.
3.	Work with local services, National SIG Bilingualism and wider groups and charities to further develop resources & good practice in working with bi/multilingual clients.
4.	Update and maintain the LSB website.
5.	Liaise with the RCSLT regarding the work of the LSB.
6.	Provide a network to support clinicians, student clinicians and other members of the multi-disciplinary team in working with clients who are bi/multilingual.
